The fall holds so much for the outdoorsmen in Idaho. It's time to put the steelhead cover back on the boat, make sure the heater works and head out. The numbers from fish and game say we are looking at the best Fall Chinook run in over 70 years. We have had many of our members already fishing for them in the Columbia and the reports are good. They fish are big and there are a lot of them.

We should be seeing these fish in the Clearwater and Salmon as this is being written. If you have not hooked into one of these beasts before, you are missing out. There are many techniques that work well depending on the area you are fishing. You can ask one of the more experienced members or hire one of the local guides to show you how.

Remember it is easy to get distracted while fishing off a moving boat. Make sure all your crew is well briefed on how to handle themselves and what is required of them.
